SECTION I. PURPOSE: To adopt policies and rules applicable to the use of the Sandgate School House.

SECTION II. POLICY AND RULES: By using the school house for a gathering or event, all persons in attendance agree to abide by the following:

- A. The school house may be used by Sandgate residents and their guests for gatherings and events from May 1 through October 31 between the hours of 10 A.M. and 10 P.M. only.
- B. Any person or group of persons wishing to use the school house must notify the Selectboard of their intention to use the building either at or prior to a Selectboard meeting which is held in advance of such use.
- C. All gatherings and events held at the school house must be open to the public free of charge.
- D. The persons using the school house shall be responsible for providing refreshments, if any, at their own expense. No alcoholic beverages shall be served or consumed, and there shall be no smoking at the school house or on school house grounds.
- E. The persons using the school house shall clean up and remove all debris immediately following each use and return the key to a designated key holder (see Town Clerk for name of current key holder). The persons using the school house are responsible for reimbursing the town, or its insurer if appropriate, for any damage to the property occurring during their gathering or event or as a result thereof.
- F. No sound amplification is permitted within the school house or on school house grounds, and no user of the school house shall generate unreasonable noise or create a nuisance.

The Selectboard reserves the right to bar any person or group that violates these policies and rules from any further use of the school house.
