OLD BUSINESS

Vacancy on ZBA and Auditor positions still unfilled Jeff Myric has been contacted about the auditors position.

Correspondence: Cassella sent the Town a check for \$368.59. It was turned over to the Treasurer. Red Cross wrote the Town concerning a request for funding. Celeste Keel emailed the Chair that she will address this.

Garage Lights: Hectic Electric gave the Town a bid of \$4520 to replace the old lights in the garage bay and put a new light over the work bench and put exit lights in. \$500 to remove and recycle old lights. Mike and Charlie will be given time to power wash the ceiling before the new lights go in. For \$700 Hectic Electric will wire the big garage doors so that they could be raised by a generator in case of power outage. The doors have had to be opened manually in the past and it's hard. Especially for one man. Also for \$1036 Hectic Electric will put in energy efficient outside lights with motion detector similar to Ruperts' new garage; they will be shaded. Rebates will be available. Ed moved to accept all of Hectic bids Mike seconded. All in favor. Weather stripping for the big doors and replacement of the little door was discussed no motion taken.

March Treasurers report was received The Town now has online banking capabilities.

NEW BUSINESS

MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE VARIABLE RATE PRICING and HAULER REGISTRATION and REPORTING ORDINANCE This ordinance was proposed and approved at this April 20, 2015 meeting to the select board. The ordinance will be posted on Town bulletin boards and the Town clerks office. It will also be published in the Banner. It will be posted on the Town website sandgatevermont.org

Road Foremans Report:

Todd Eaton from the State went over the Town roads with Mike; he had suggestions for Lincoln Rd and the West Sandgate Rd [from Lucille Kurasinskis to Jean Eisenharts] These might be considered for 2016 fabric projects. The applications for the SE Corner Rd and Audy Turn will be submitted by May 15th no work will take place on those projects till the we hear from the State.

Paving options were discussed; Mike should have figures and options for consideration by the whole board at the next meeting. Also what needs to be done to maintain the 2014 blacktop.

A 2500 gallon tank to hold liquid chloride needs to be purchased. Mike's checking on costs. Ed has plastic drums and Mike will be able to make a tank to spread the chloride with the 1 ton truck.
