As lister Jean Zoppel let the board know the State has granted an extension for the filing of the Grand List. We should be able to set the Tax Rate mid July. The Cemetery Commission would like the Town Road crew to remove brush and dead trees from the Center Cemetery. The Board gave its approval.

The Sandgate Church wanted to gravel the area used for Church parking Rick Dahm objected saying he felt the current owners of the "Mears Property" should have a say. He felt the Town did not have a deed to the property and could not let the Church put gravel in the school yard. The Board will check into ownership.

Grinding of the SE Corner Rd to Tudor Hill Rd will start this week Paving to follow weather depending. One more culvert has to be replaced because of its depth the road will have to be closed. Traffic will detour over the Woodcock Rd. Mike will check with Arlington for signs and will let the Fire department and Rescue Squad know.

The Select Board signed a \$4000 contract with Nikon to do the oil sealing for a day. Mike Hill will do the Town Road mowing not on town time his equipment for 50/hour Crown Maple has not gotten back to the Town with their promise to help with "mud spots" on the road to Beartown.

Cloride tanks are still on their way.  
Costs for bridge work are still coming in Amounts are huge. Alternatives are being explored.

Ed moved to adjourn at 9:00PM Tom seconded All in favor.
