

Sandgate Select Board Meeting – March 12, 2018

Called to order at 6:45 pm

Attendance: Board members Mike Hill, Tom Santelli, Suzanne dePeyster, Karen Tendrup, Karen Dzialo

Board Organization: Suzanne dePeyster as Chairperson, Tom Santelli as Road Liason, Karen Dzialo as Clerk/minute taker. Nominated by Karen Tendrup, 2nd by Tom Santelli, all in favor.

Continued Discussion on Sheriff Contract: the Board agreed to accept and sign the contract for the time period of March 15 through June 30, 2018. It was requested that Sheriff contact Mike or Tom for the best times and days to patrol the roads.

Dry Hydrant Update: The Town is still waiting on the fire department for input on the Perra West Road site regarding hydrant height. If there is a fire, the pond can still be used for water.

Karen Tendrup motioned to adjourn, Karen Dzialo seconded. All in favor.
