

Sandgate Select Board Meeting – September 17, 2018

Call to Order: 6:45 pm

Citizens' Concerns: none

Treasurer's Report : Reviewed by Board. It was noted that the Town has \$4,488 left in the budget for the Sheriff to patrol the town.

Sheriff Patrol: It was agreed to stop the patrol in mid-October and restart in the Spring. Tom will contact the Sheriff. Discussion to ask at Town Meeting if residents would like to increase the amount allotted for the Sheriff patrol.

Planning Board and Zoning Board Vacancies: Town residents Carolyn Kimball, Stuart Stevens, and Shelia Kearns have shown interest in filling the vacancies.

Dog Warden: Note that Small Animal Officer, Erin McDermott has a new telephone number 802-379-9246

Haggerty's Cows: The town received another complaint that Bill Haggerty's cows are getting out. Bill explained that he is unaware of the cows getting out and does not check his phone very often for messages. He told the Board that he has worked on the fence the best that he could.

It was noted that Bill's sheep are also often in the road.

Road Report: Hamilton Hollow is almost done.

All grading has been completed in the town. It was noted that the addition of liquid chloride to all the dirt roads has resulted in less dust because after grading the road packs down much faster.

Mike reported that he is getting ready for winter and ordering sand and salt.

Mike told the Board that Mark Scanlon has been told that he needs to move his truck (Hamilton Hollow) so that a new telephone pole can be installed. It was suggested to tell Mr. Scanlon that Dorr will be contacted to move truck and that it will be at the truck owner's expense.

Willie Mattison will be available again this winter season for snow plowing. Tom Santelli will back up as needed.

Other Business: The Storm Water permit has been sent in
